

This section contains all the data from the seven Baslow and Bubnell Censuses. I believe the transcription is fairly accurate.

I have added two columns, the first is a simple entry number, the second is a year of birth calculated from the age. It proves that not everyone gave an accurate age! Variation of a year or two is common, more in the 1841 census.

Some descriptions have been abbreviated for consistency and space. Agricultural and Apprentice for instance become Ag and App.

I have kept the original spelling of names, so there is sometimes variation from year to year.

Each file can be searched on the web site.

The last census entry "Baslow Census 1841 – 1911" is an Excel File containing all the censuses together. Clicking on it will download it to your hard disc, where Excel or compatible programmes can make detailed analyses.
