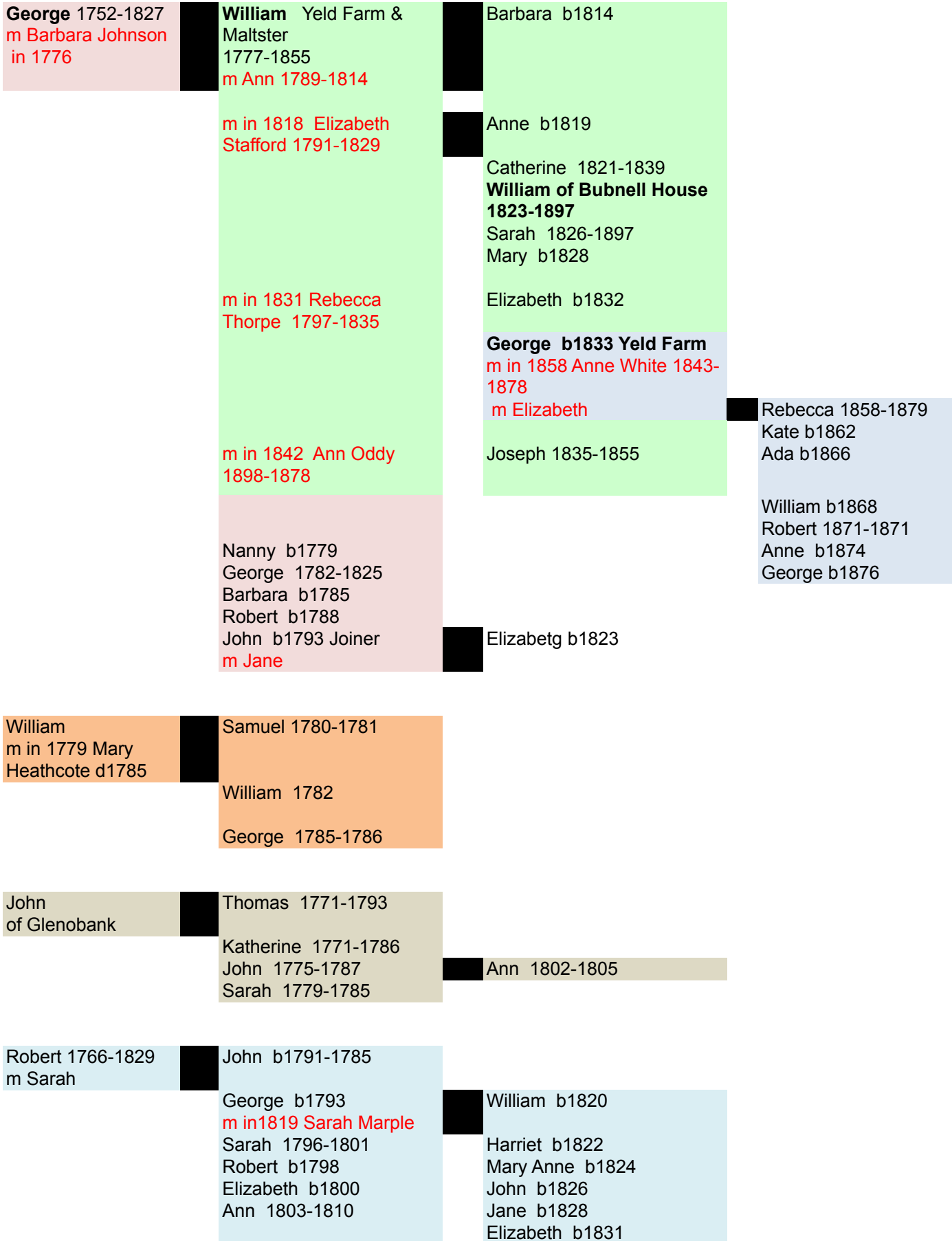


The Hattersley Tree



Hattersley Family

The family is first noted in Baslow 1766 when Robert married Sarah. There were 4 new arrivals in the village about this time – possibly brothers. George, William, John and Robert

George born in 1752, married in 1776 and died in 1827 had most effect in the village.

His son William 1777-1855 was in Yeldwood Farm in 1841. It is possible that he moved in when the new Turnpike arrived in 1805. It divided Yeld Farm land into two. Gardom retained the larger east side, and Hattersely took over the area between the new road and the Barbrook.

It seems that he married 4 times, the last to Ann Oddy, of Bubnell Hall Farm

In 1848 he owned The Malt House, possible bought from William Kitchin around 1824

His son George inherited Yeldwood Farm

His eldest son William was the first farmer at the new model farm in Bubnell which opened in 1885. He died a bachelor in 1897
