Boys school Bakewell, 1928 Chester College, Langwith School,

1931 Deputy head, Bakewell, 1934 Head Baslow school. Retired 1967

Sheldon Family From Edensor

A minor Sheldon family in Edensor village, Thomas Sheldon, b1805, was servant at Chatsworth , retired to New buildings in Baslow.

Married Emily Smith, who in 1861 committed suicide while "mentally disturbed" (drowned in Derwent near old bridge).

Son Edmund b1856. Druggist and Grocer in Hanover Street Sheffield until eventually retired to Hanover Cottage

Married Sarah Bates, daug of Thomas (retired policemen who lived in Hanover Cott), then Catherine Tomlinson (widow Rutland Arms). Father of Emily Broughton b1880 – Broughton's Caravan site in Calver
