John and his wife Elizabeth were both born in Halifax, Yorkshire and spent their early married life they. Their youngest child Anna was born in Ashbourne, so they may have been living there before coming to Bubnell where they lived in Bubnell Cottage (at the entrance to the drive to Bubnell Hall)

Members of the Halliwell family appear in the Baslow Censuses from 1871 to 1911

In 1871 the head of household was John Halliwell a 71 year old wool buyer. He must have been wealthy as he was one of only 2 in Baslow and Bubnell to employ a coachman, and he entertained a retired steel merchant from the USA.

He died in 1878, and his wife 5 years later. His daughters remained in the cottage, Emma & Anna until after 1911, describing themselves are farmers though no doubt they had an inheritance to support them
